


ENERSOL RUBBER REPAIR

TO REPAIR SMALL ISOLATED HOLE

- 1. Make a small cut in the channel of the panel on each side of the hole.
- **2.** Make a small cut across the hole.
- **3.** Insert barbed splicer into the open ends of the tube.





TO REPAIR LARGE HOLES

If the hole is larger, it is possible to make a larger repair with a small piece of panel rubber and barbed splicers.

- 1. Make a larger splicer by cutting out a tube(s) from a spare piece of rubber cut to the proper length, and insert a barbed splicer in each end of each tube.
- **2.** Cut out the damaged tube from the panel and insert the splicer.
